Highlights of 2025

- *Women attended 44 sessions spanning 7 Bible study courses.*
- *Cup of Grace – A fellowship welcoming all women seeking community and connection.*
- *Ladies Night Out – A quarterly evening gathering designed to foster community, provide encouragement, and create opportunities for fellowship among women.*
- *Pastoral Care – Ongoing confidential counseling and support provided to women throughout the year.*
- *Volunteer Development – Three new volunteers completed 40 hours of professional counseling training to expand ministry capacity.*
